Betty Arlene Toy, 93, of Pleasant Hill and formerly of Oskaloosa, passed away Saturday, March 16, 2019, at Parkridge Specialty Care in Pleasant Hill.

Betty Toy, the devoted daughter of William Lester Toy and Phoebe Blanche (Johnson) Toy, was born March 1, 1926, in Oskaloosa, Iowa. She attended Oskaloosa schools and later worked at Ideal Manufacturing. She retired in 1983 and in 2004 she moved to Des Moines to be closer to her family.
