



## Angela VanDerVeer

February 19, 1967 - May 28, 2024

Angela VanDerVeer, 57, of Beacon, passed away Tuesday, May 28, 2024, at the home of her daughter in Oskaloosa.

Angela Marie VanDerVeer, daughter of Nathan Duane and Linda Mae (Ferguson) Stouwie, was born February 19, 1967, in Oskaloosa, Iowa. Angie grew up on a farm near Union Mills and then in New Sharon. She attended New Sharon schools, where she played the trumpet, was a color guard member in the band, and was part of the cheer squad. She married Jason VanDerVeer, and after her daughter was born, she stayed home to care for her. She and Jason later divorced. Eventually, Angie went to work at Pella Plastics and then decided to study Nursing at Indian Hills Community College. After completing her studies there, she was hired at the Christian Opportunity Center in Pella. She worked as a Motor Skills Coordinator “in physical therapy” for the last 28 years. Angie loved spending time with her grandchildren and taking photos of them. She also loved helping her special friend, Melia, at her taco stand. She enjoyed riding motorcycles, camping, boating, fishing, attending races, and mushroom hunting in her free time.
