Beth (Elizabeth) K. Hamilton: Beth died peacefully at her home in Chanhassen, Minnesota with her family at her side on Thursday, May 17, 2007 at the age of 69 years, 11 months and 15 days.

She is survived by devoted daughters, Debora (David) Hamilton-Altendorf, Minnetonka, MN, and Angie (Troy) Weadge, Shakopee, MN; cherished grandchildren, Andrea Hamilton and Owen Weadge; sisters Mary Anne Hesling, Oskaloosa, IA, and Josephine Fageol, Burlington, IA, and many nieces and nephews.

Beth was born June 2, 1937, in Oskaloosa, IA, to Mary Walling Hamilton and John F. Hamilton, Jr. She attended Oskaloosa High School. After raising her family, she pursued many different career paths. She worked for Contech, Inc., in Edina, MN, as an administrative assistant for 5 years. She was a past member of ULLR Ski, Bike and Social Club, in Minneapolis/St. Paul, and loved to sail the Great Lakes. Moving to Grand Rapids, MN, she pursued a life-long desire and became a radio announcer for a local radio station. During this time, she gave loving care to her son during his courageous battle against cancer. After his death in 1980, she returned to Minneapolis to be close to her daughters. She

obtained a position as advertising coordinator for Tack-N-Togs magazine with Miller Publishing. She retired in 1997 after 11 years of service. Her retirement days were enjoyed by traveling, becoming computer and digital camera savvy, attending the theatre, joining and following the Four Freshmen Society and listening to her broad collection of music.

Besides her parents, Mary and John Hamilton, Jr., she was preceded in death by her beloved son, Robert Pruisner, and a sister, Jean Chapman.
