Betty Marie Gallagher: Betty passed away Wednesday, July 20, 2005, at the home of her son, Bob, in Dixon, Illinois at the age of 82 years and 4 months.

Those left to cherish her memory are her two sons: Jeff (Pat) Gallagher of Bonham, TX; and Bob (Tina) Gallagher of Dixon, IL; five granddaughters: Traci (Mike) Kincade; Nicole (Mike) Crowell; Tianna (Mike) Herrick; Kayla Gallagher and Haley Gallagher; and three great grandchildren. Betty Marie Gallagher, daughter of Horace & Eula Evans Ferguson was born March 20th 1923 in Barnes City, Iowa. She was a 1940 graduate of Barnes City High School. On October 22, 1940 she married William B. Gallagher in Ottumwa, IA. During WWII she worked briefly as a retail sales clerk. After the war, she & Bill lived in Oskaloosa for a short while; in 1946 they moved to Guthrie Center. In 1960 they moved to Dixon, IL, where they raised their family. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church, where she helped with the Food Pantry Program. She served as the original secretary for the Ronald Reagan Home, now the Reagan Foundation. Betty dedicated her life to her family and home; she will always be remembered as a great mom and grandma.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, William on March 18, 1981; a son, Patrick Kelly Gallagher on February 8, 1942; a great grandson, Michael David Kincade and a brother, Court Ferguson.
