Betty Gay, 90, of Rose Hill, passed away Saturday, April 19, 2025, at the Mahaska Health Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa.

Betty Elaine Gay, daughter of Everett "Pat" Ray and Dorothy Lamoine (Poe) Dunwoody, was born October 5, 1934, at her parents' rural home north of Eddyville, Iowa. She graduated 8th grade from Charter Oak Country School and then worked in Oskaloosa at the New Method Café and, later, at Ideal Manufacturing for four years. November 14, 1954, Betty was united in marriage to Vernon Wayne Gay at the Central United Methodist Church in Oskaloosa. They made their home on a farm NE of Oskaloosa near Rose Hill. Betty assisted Vernon in their business, Gay Plumbing and Electric, which they operated for over 55 years. She was a busy farm wife and mother of four children: gardening, canning, cooking, and baking. Betty was a First Assembly of God Church member in Oskaloosa and faithfully attended the OK Bunch gatherings. She was also a member of the Dutch Masters Car Club, Nelson Pioneer Farm, the Gingham Girls Club, and the Iowa Water Well Association. She enjoyed traveling with her husband, Vernon, once to Europe, on many state bus trips, and to several Water Well Association conventions. Betty was an excellent cook and pie baker and taught each of her children and grandchildren to make noodles. She will be remembered fondly for her quiet smile and generous heart.
