Beulah Sherman: Beulah F. Sherman, daughter of John W. and Edith T. (Barnes) Binns was born March 18, 1914 in Oskaloosa, Iowa. She attended school and was a graduate of the Oskaloosa High School, class of 1932. She was united in marriage to Cecil F. Sherman on June 19, 1938 in Oskaloosa, Iowa. She and her husband resided in or near Tracy most of their lives. Cecil preceded her in death on September 11, 1976. Beulah was a member of the Tracy Methodist Church and was an avid reader of her Bible. (She had a yearly goal to completely read her Bible from cover to cover and accomplished this goal for many years.)
