Bill LeRoy Myers: Bill passed away early Friday morning, December 24, 2004 at the Sigourney Care Center at the age of 78 years, 6 months and 2 days. His body has been cremated and no services are planned.

He joined the U.S. Navy in July 1943 and served in the Island Campaign until the end of WWII. After the war, he served on a destroyer, the USS Flusser and witnessed two atomic bomb tests. He was discharged in 1947. In 1951 he joined the USAF, serving on B29's ? B36's & B-52's. During Korea he served on bombing raids over North Korea. Bill remained in the Air Force through the Vietnam era and was Honorably Retired on Aug. 1, 1967 at Griffis Air Force Base, New York. After his retirement from the military he was an instructor and two engine charter pilot until 1972, when a heart attack ended his flying career. He worked as a truck driver until his retirement in 1992. Bill was also a professional motorcycle racer and also raced go-karts and stock cars into his 70's. He loved flying small airplanes.

Bill LeRoy Myers, son of Jack & Dolores Greenwalt Myers was born June 22, 1926 at his home near Denver, CO. He married Beverly Spargo in Sept, 1945; they had two children, Linda & Michael. They divorced in 1947. He married Ritta J. Crow on May 1, 1948; they had two children, Christine & William.

Bill is survived by his wife, Ritta Myers of Delta, IA and his children & their spouses: Linda & Floyd Thistle and Michael Myers, all of Oroville, WA; and Christine Myers of Delta, IA and William & Billie Myers of Harper, IA. He was blessed with three granddaughters: Emmie and Cloie Myers and Juliette Swope; and 2 great grandsons: Ethan & Harrison Swope. He is also survived by two brothers: George R. and John H. Myers, both of Ventura, CA
