Bryan Dykstra, 61, of Fremont passed away Wednesday, September 22, 2021, at his home in Fremont.

Bryan Leigh Dykstra, son of Bevan Leigh and Lois Jane (Dunwoody) Dykstra was born December 30, 1959, in Oskaloosa. He was raised on a farm in rural Eddyville and attended Eddyville schools. After his education, he farmed with his father. Bryan was truly a man of all trades, as he worked with a variety of companies in the Eddyville area while continuing to farm. He enjoyed fishing, but spending time with his daughter and grandchildren was the highlight of his life. Reading the “funnies” in the newspaper was a favorite pastime with his grandchildren, as this generated very robust laughs.

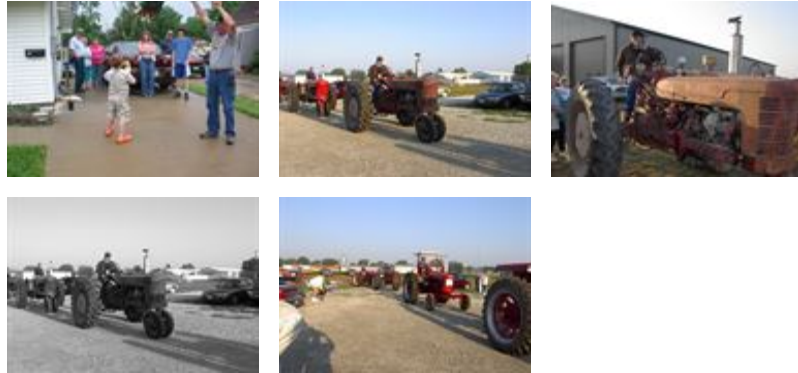
