Carl McMurray: Carl passed away early Monday evening at the Mahaska Health Partnership Hospice Services Serenity House at the age of 98 years, 2 months and 22 days.

Carl's passion was for helping children and youth; for over 50 years, he raised funds for and provided transportation to the Shriners' Hospital in Minneapolis.
