Carleton M. Meinders: Carleton passed away Friday morning at Mercy Medical Center in Des Moines at the age of 79 years, 5 months and 10 days.

Carleton's family includes his wife Nellie of New Sharon; his two daughters: Dorothy Hester of New Sharon, and Carol Meinders of Burnsville, MN; his son: Carleton Meinders Jr. of New Sharon; and one grandson Clayton Hester of New Sharon.
