Charles Warren France: Warren passed away Wednesday morning at the Mahaska Hospital in Oskaloosa at the age of 86 years, 3 months and 3 days.

Warren's family includes his wife, Gladys of Oskaloosa; his daughters: Lynn Dew of Ottumwa; Barbara (Don) McKay of Oskaloosa; five grandchildren: Elizabeth (Robert) Gates of Platteville, WI; Jon (Carrie) McKay of Moab, UT; Tom (Kari) McKay of Gypsum, CO; and Eric and Michael McKay, both of Oskaloosa; eight great grandchildren; a sister, Mildred Schuerman of Sun City, AZ; and brothers: James France of Cedar Rapids and Richard (Ann) France of Simpsonville, SC.

Charles Warren France, son of Charles W. and Jeanette Smith France, was born February 7, 1920, in rural Oskaloosa. He was a 1938 graduate of Oskaloosa High School and then attended Iowa State University. In 1940, he married Gladys Louise Ver Ploeg at her parent's home S.W. of Oskaloosa. Together they made their home and farmed 9 miles N.E. of Oskaloosa until his retirement in 1986, when they moved to Oskaloosa. Warren served on the Oskaloosa School Board for 9 years, the Bank Iowa Board for 28 years and the Soil Conservation Board. He was a member of the Central United Methodist Church. He enjoyed golfing, fishing and dabbling in the stock market.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a sister, Margaret Vasey; brothers: Keith and Howard France; and a son-in-law & fishing buddy, Bill Dew.
