Charles Allen Lynch, "Charlie," age 74, of Oskaloosa, passed away March 24, 2024, at his home in Oskaloosa.

Charlie was born August 17, 1949, in Mahaska County, son of Lawrence and Lois (Atherton) Lynch. Charles graduated from Oskaloosa High School with the class of 1967. On June 26, 1968, he was united in marriage to Marietta Louise Brower.

After graduation, he worked at multiple factories around Oskaloosa and surrounding communities (hated them all). At the age of 23, he started his own business, Lynch Auto.
