Chet Richards: Chet died Wednesday morning at his home at White Oak Estates.

His family includes a son, Russ (Cecilia) Richards of Helendale, Calif.; a grandson, Chet Wade (Jeannie) Richards of Apple Valley, Calif. and a great grandson, Brendon (Kailey) Richards, also of Apple Valley.

Chester Clemont Richards was born July 10, 1914 in Albia, Iowa to Joner and Nell Clark Richards. He was a graduate of Chariton High School. He married Mona Louise Enslow in November of 1940 in Missouri. Chet enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served from March 30, 1942 until his discharge March 12th 1945. While in the Navy Chet served as an aviation machinist and was stationed in Pensacola, Florida. Following his discharge Chet and Mona made their home in Oskaloosa and Chet worked as a feed salesman for Moorman Feeds. He retired in 1971. Chet was a member of the First Christian Church, the Elks Lodge and the American Legion. He loved to play cribbage and spend time with friends.

Besides his parents, Chet was preceded in death by his wife Mona in 2002 and three brothers: Raymond, Donald and William Richards.
