David L. Day: David died Monday at his home in San Diego at the age of 63 years, 2 months and 11 days.

His family includes his wife, Sue Day of San Diego; a step-son, Geoffrey Wilkie of San Diego; his mother, Vivian Day of Oskaloosa; a brother, Bill (Terri) Day of Cedar Rapids, Iowa; a sister, Vicki West of Fairfield, Iowa; a mother-in-law, Faye Brussel of San Diego; and nephews: Tyler West of West Des Moines and Alex West and Justin Day, both of Oskaloosa.

David Lawrence Day, son of Lanile Frank and Vivian Irene Jordan Day, was born May 22, 1947 in Oskaloosa. He attended Oskaloosa High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy May 28, 1965. He served during the Viet Nam War and was detached to a Sea Bee battalion as a naval hull technician. He advanced to a nuclear hull technician where his job responsibilities included welding on nuclear submarines and on nuclear power plant components. He served in the Navy for 22 years and was discharged August 5, 1987. While in the Navy he was home based in San Diego and continued to live there after his discharge. He married Sue Brussel June 14, 1980 in San Diego. At the

time of his death he was employed with Sea World as a safety manager, a position he had held for 17 years. Dave enjoyed traveling in his R.V. to week-end rallies. He was an avid race and NASCAR fan and enjoyed collecting NASCAR die cast models.

Dave was preceded in death by his father and father-in-law.
