Dennis Jackson: Dennis died unexpectedly early Tuesday morning at the Knoxville Community Hospital at the age of 61 years, 3 months and 16 days.

His family includes his wife of 29 years, Linda Jackson of Harvey; three daughters: Amanda (Scotty) Edge of Bonaire, Ga.; Shawnee (Porfirio) Garcia; and Trina (John) Nickel of Bondurant, Iowa; seven grandchildren: Daria, Dennis and Dominick Garcia; Colin and Casey Nickel; and Cole and Emily Edge; three brothers: Kenneth and June Jackson and Gregory and Melinda Jackson, both of Hartford, Iowa; and Christopher and Eva Jackson of Burlington, Vt. and numerous nieces and nephews.

Dennis Mitchell Jackson, son of Maxwell and Marvel Johannes Jackson, was born April 4, 1949 in Oskaloosa. He was a 1967 graduate of Oskaloosa High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Army October 6, 1967. He served in Vietnam with the 19th Division Combat Engineers and among numerous commendations and honors his unit was awarded the Medal of Valor and he was personally awarded four Bronze Stars. He was discharged from active duty September 30, 1970, but continued to serve with the Army Reserves until October 5, 1973. After his discharge, Dennis attended heavy equipment operator's school in Florida and worked for Pabst Brewing Company in Georgia and an electrical company in Cedar Rapids. In 1976 he began a 20 year career with Hormel in Knoxville as a meat packer. Dennis married Linda

Joyce Landers December 20, 1980 in Corydon, Iowa and they made their home in Harvey. Dennis enjoyed hunting, fishing and boating, and working his vegetable garden. Dennis' family was what he enjoyed the most; he loved spending time with his daughters and grandchildren and also family reunions with brothers, uncles, aunts and cousins.

Dennis was preceded in death by his parents.
