Diana Provenzano, 83, of Grinnell and formerly of Oskaloosa passed away Wednesday, September 9, 2020, at the Grinnell Health Care Center in Grinnell.

Diana Laura Provenzano was born April 8, 1938, in Oskaloosa to Walter and Lucile (Whitlock) Gravitt. She was a 1956 graduate of Oskaloosa High School. In 1958, Diana married Frank Provenzano and they made their home in Illinois; to this union, three children were born. They later divorced. In 1973, Diana returned to Oskaloosa with her children.
