August 17, 1929 - January 1, 2024

Dolores Fynaardt, 94, of Oskaloosa, passed away Monday, January 1, 2024, at Mahaska Health Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa.

Dorothy Dolores Fynaardt, daughter of John and Julia (Matejzel) Antolik, was born on August 17, 1929, in Woodhull, Illinois. Dolores attended school in Woodhull through the 5th grade when the family moved to the Eddyville area to farm. She attended country school through 8th grade and graduated from Eddyville High School in 1947. Following her education, she was hired in the lab at Mahaska County Hospital.

On February 6, 1949, Dolores was united in marriage to Henry John Fynaardt at St. John Lutheran Church in Oskaloosa. They made their home on the family farm near Eddyville. Dolores stayed home to help Henry with the farming and raise their three children. In her later years, Dolores was active as a hospice volunteer for ten years. She was a member of St John Lutheran Church, where she participated in the Ladies Guild.
