Doris Van Wyk, 85, of Oskaloosa passed away Friday morning, September 20, 2019, at the Mahaska Health Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa.

Doris Joan Van Wyk, daughter of Cordia and Margaret (Iverson) Wilkinson, was born September 2, 1934, at the rural home of her parents near Chelsea, Iowa. She was a 1952 graduate of Grinnell High School.

Doris worked for Van Zee Motors for 14 years as a bookkeeper. She worked as a bookkeeper for Solar Fence as well. She went on to work as a dispatcher at Circle B Transportation and retired from Iowa Workforce Development in 2002.
