Edward William Klyn: Ed passed away Friday at his home in Apache Junction, AZ at the age of 69 years, 1 month and 9 days.

Ed's family includes his wife, Alice Klyn of Apache Junction, AZ; sons: Steve E. Klyn of Mesa, AZ and Michael L. (Julia) Klyn of Ottumwa, IA and a daughter, Kathy J. (Bill) Corbin of Glen Ellyn, IL and five grandchildren.

Edward William Klyn, son of Gerrit H. and Marie Augusta Mathes Klyn, was born June 25, 1937, in Jasper County, IA, near Knoxville. He attended rural schools in Jasper and Marion Counties and attended high school in Pella. February 14, 1958, he married Alice Van Alst in Oskaloosa, IA. In the early years of their marriage, Ed drove a truck for Oskaloosa Produce, Mich Coal Company, the City of Oskaloosa, Hensyl Trucking and others. He later purchased a farm on the Ottumwa-Eddyville Highway and farmed until 1977. At that time he sold the farm, built a home west of Ottumwa and started Klyn Grain and Trucking. A business which bought, sold and transported grain. He and his son, Steve, operated the business until 1984, when Ed retired, and he and Alice sold their home and moved to Arizona. They have resided in Apache Junction since that time, spending frequent summers in Iowa and Illinois; all done with the help and pleasure of their three wonderful children: Steve, Mike and Kathy. Ed was a past member of the American Legion, Post 27 of Apache Junction, AZ.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Mary Ann Worall.
