Ferman F. Lane: Ferman passed away early Friday morning, Nov. 25, at the Mahaska Hospital in Oskaloosa at the age of 80 years, 4 months and 19 days.

Kuester on May 5, 1954 in Evansville. He received his Bachelors Degree from the University of Evansville and a Masters Degree in Education from Indiana University in Bloomington, IN. He was a reading specialist in the elementary school system in Indiana for many years; retiring in 1989. He became a member of the LCMS Lutheran Church in Bloomington, IN in 1958; he has served the LCMS church faithfully in numerous positions since that time. He and his wife relocated in 2001 to Oskaloosa and he is currently a member of St. John Lutheran Church. Ferman enjoyed classical music and Chicago Cubs Baseball.
