Glen Chance: Glen was born in rural Monroe County, Iowa on September 22, 1914 to Fred Joseph Chance and Beatrice Sarah Lambertson. He married Rosemary Kerr on September 9, 1944 in Albia, Iowa. Both he and Rosemary devoted their lives to the teaching profession. Glen was an Elementary Principal at Garfield and Jefferson Elementary Schools in Oskaloosa. He was involved in the teaching profession for 37 years, retiring in the 1980's.

Glen is survived by three nieces: Rowena Shelford of Lovilia; Janette Flahive of Albia; Beverly Sampson of Arlington, Virginia; one nephew, Donnie Tucker of Lovilia; and a brother-in-law, Keith Brunt of Eddyville. He is also survived by several of his wife Rosemary's nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife of 59 years, Rosemary; his parents; and two sisters; Leona Yates and Loretta Tucker.

Glen was a member of the First Christian Church of Oskaloosa, The Farm Bureau, The American Legion, The National Education Association, and he served in the 11th Armored Division of the US Army.
