Glenn Elwood Thorn: Glen passed away Saturday afternoon, April 1, 2006 at the Veteran's Administration Hospital in Knoxville, IA at the age 82 years, 11 months and 18 days. He has chosen to donate his body to science.

Glenn is survived by his wife, Lillian Thorn of Oskaloosa; two daughters: Cindy (Chuck) Thomas and Chris (Greg Carmer) Krile, both of Oskaloosa; three step children: Richard (Jane) Ullrick of Eddyville; Linda King of Beacon and Carol (Chris) Kent of Las Vegas, NV; seventeen grandchildren; and 15 great grandchildren.

He was born in Montezuma, IA on April 13, 1923, an only child of parents, John H. and Anna (Mouchka) Thorn. Following graduation from Montezuma High School he entered the military, serving two terms of duty. He first served in the Army during WWII, from 1943 to 1946; he reenlisted in the Army in 1948 and served until 1952. Glenn married Lillian Inez (Wymore) Ullrick on December 22, 1955; they recently celebrated 50 years together. Glenn was employed as a mechanic at the Buick Garage and the Texaco Station; he held various positions at Superior/Ideal Manufacturing, he last worked there as a shipping clerk, retiring after 25 years. Following retirement, Glenn worked at Mahaska Hospital as a part time maintenance man. He enjoyed many activities & hobbies over the years, including motorcycles, race cars, hunting, music, dancing and bingo. He was a member of the Eagles Lodge and the

American Legion.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
