Goldie Faith Chance: Goldie passed away early Monday morning at the Crystal Heights Nursing Home where she had been a resident since December 2007. She was 90 years, 10 months and 21 days of age.

Goldie's family includes her son and daughters-in-law, Richard and Karen Chance of New Brighton, MN, and Elizabeth Holliday-Allison of Eddyville, IA; and her daughter and sons-in-law, Betty & Lonnie Shullaw of Eddyville and Dan Troxel of Kirkville, IA. She was blessed with eleven grandchildren, 20 great grandchildren and 7 great great grandchildren.

Goldie Faith Chance, daughter of Thomas Jefferson and Amanda Agnes Long Silvers, was born February 21, 1917 in Tracy, Iowa. She attended rural Mahaska County Schools. She married John Baker Holliday in 1933 and they lived near Oskaloosa. To this union was born three children, John, Betty and Joanne. They later divorced. A job with National Travelers Insurance Company took her to Des Moines after her divorce. While living in Des Moines she met Frank Chance and on October 20, 1955, while they were visiting friends in Wyoming, they married. They returned to Des Moines where they made their home. Goldie continued with National Travelers Insurance, retiring in the mid 1960s, after 20 years of service. In 1970, she and Frank moved to Alexandria, Minnesota. She remained there until Frank's death in 1998, when she moved back to Eddyville to be near family. Goldie enjoyed spending time

with her family and doing embroidery work.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband, a son, John Holliday, a daughter, Joann Troxel, two brothers, Jesse and Guy Silvers and a sister, Mary Cameron.
