Helen Margery Grace Flanders: Helen passed away Saturday afternoon at the Adel Acres Care Center in Adel, where she had been a resident since 1999. She was 97 years, 4 months and 13 days of age.

Flanders, they made their home in Oskaloosa. Helen was employed by Mahaska Overall Manufacturing for 24 years. She also enjoyed sewing, crocheting, knitting, and quilting at home. Two large gardens kept her busy with produce for canning and cooking. These were two of her favorite pastimes.

Helen demonstrated her great faith by way of action. As a very active member of Lacey United Methodist Church, Helen made cookies, pies, and helped with soup suppers. She passed on her values to her extended family by means of discipline, stewardship, commitment, and love. Helen read her bible daily and shared her insights with her family.
