



## Henry John Fynaardt

August 20, 1928 - April 27, 2023

Henry Fynaardt, 94, of Oskaloosa and formerly of Eddyville, passed away Thursday, Apr. 27, 2023, at Mahaska Health Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa.

Henry John Fynaardt, son of John Tunis and Grada "Grace" (Van Oene) Fynaardt, was born Aug. 20, 1928, at his parents' home in Pleasant Township Monroe County, near Eddyville. He attended country school and then Eddyville High School, where he graduated in 1947. He married Dolores Antolik on Feb. 6, 1949, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Oskaloosa. They made their home on the family farm and raised their three children together. Henry will be remembered as being a steward of the land and was the recipient of numerous agricultural awards through the years. In addition to working the land, Henry enjoyed raising cattle. He remained on the farm until 2010 and then retired to Oskaloosa. Henry cared about his community and served on the school board for four years. He was a member of the Farm Bureau and the St. John Lutheran Church.
