James "Jim" Horn, 67 of Oskaloosa passed away Tuesday, November 8, 2016, at Unity Point Iowa Methodist Hospital in Des Moines.

James Stephen Horn, son of Alayos and Amelia (Fedal) Horn, was born September 14, 1949, in St. Louis, MO. He was a 1967 graduate of Maplewood High School in Maplewood, Missouri. He married Dede Wells, September 9, 1972, in Oskaloosa. They made their home in Oskaloosa and Jim began his employment with 3M in Knoxville. He worked at 3M in the lab for 33 years, retiring in 2007. Jim enjoyed nature and the out-of-doors and also enjoyed collecting various types of memorabilia. He had great compassion for children with special needs because of his brother's and grandchildren's special needs.
