Jim DeWitt, 59, of Oskaloosa passed away early Saturday, March 18, 2017, at the MHP Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa.

Jim LeRoy DeWitt, son of Cecil Raymond and Mabel Marie (DeMoney) DeWitt, was born April 24, 1957, in Oskaloosa, Iowa. He was a 1975 graduate of Oskaloosa High School.
