Joan Macksey, 87, of Oskaloosa passed away early Sunday morning, June 29, 2014, at Mahaska Health Partnership in Oskaloosa after a brief illness.

Joan Marie Macksey, daughter of Francis Joseph and Eugenia Kathryn Lechty Boyle, was born, July 18, 1926, in Iowa City, Iowa. Joan was a graduate of St. Patrick's High School in Iowa City, Iowa. She then attended Marycrest College in Davenport where she studied journalism. While visiting her roommate, Rose (Sister Karen) Macksey's home in Oskaloosa, she met her future husband, Earl Macksey. She married Earl Ellis Macksey, June 16, 1947, at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Iowa City. They made their home in Oskaloosa where Earl was a Postal Clerk.
