Jouetta Jeanne Baker: Jeanne passed away Monday at her daughter's home in Marshall, Missouri at the age of 89 years, 11 months and 28 days.

Jeanne is survived by her husband of 65 years, Samuel Ward Baker; 2 daughters, PJ Baker and Laurie Cook; 4 grandsons, Wyn and Randy Auer, Guy and Nick Cook; 5 great grandchildren, Gavin, Hunter and Grace Cook and Cristian and Cassady Auer. Jeanne is preceded in death by her parents and brother.

Jeanne was born August 17, 1916, in Emporia, Kansas, the daughter of William James Widby and Winifred Pearl Richards Widby. She attended school in Sioux City, Iowa. She met Samuel Ward Baker in Des Moines, Iowa in 1939 and they were married April 26, 1941. After Ward was discharged from the service, they took up residence in Bakersfield, California. They lived in Bakersfield until February, 2006, when they returned to the Midwest. Jeanne worked in the Human Resources and Personnel fields for over 40 years. After retirement she and Ward became very active in the Kern County Shrine Club. Jeanne was also an active member in the Ladies Oriental Shrine, Kern County Republican Women's Federation, Hi Twelve/Twelvettes and the Order of Eastern Star.
