Juanita M. Boland: Juanita passed away early Tuesday morning, November 22, at Mahaska Hospital in Oskaloosa after suffering a stroke on Saturday afternoon, Nov. 19. She was 81 years, 4 months and 7 days of age.

Juanita's family includes her husband Earl Boland of Oskaloosa; a son, Richard (Nancy) Boland of Oskaloosa; a daughter, Linda (Jim) Reid of Metamora, IL; two grandsons, Bill (Ann) Reid of Columbus, IN and Nicholas Boland of Oskaloosa; a granddaughter, Laura Reid of Birmingham, AL; and a brother, Albert (Maurine) Reis of Burlington, IA.

Juanita Boland, daughter of Henry and Minnie Post Reis, was born July 15, 1924 in Melrose, Iowa. She attended Monroe County Schools. On February 10, 1943 she married Earl R. Boland in Unionville, MO. After Earl finished his military tour of duty, they lived in Albia for a short time before moving to Ottumwa, where they lived for 10 years. There Juanita worked at Younkers Department Store. In 1959, she and Earl moved to Oskaloosa. There she worked for Younkers until the time it closed and then the Graham's Department Store, where she worked until her retirement in 1986. She was a member of the Central United Methodist Church, United Methodist Women, Christian Challenge One, a 35 year member of Centennial Circle of Kings Daughters, Oskaloosa Women's Club, the Historical Society, Mahaska

Hospice Auxiliary and the Mahaska Hospital Auxiliary Board. Juanita enjoyed gardening, attending auctions, cooking and baking, knitting, playing cards with friends and spending time with her grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents and a brother, Raymond Reis.
