October 31, 1944 - June 22, 2025

Kenny Kennedy Jr., 80, of Oskaloosa, passed away Sunday, June 22, 2025, at his home in Oskaloosa.

Kenneth Eugene Kennedy, son of Kenneth Eugene Sr. and Gladys Marie (White) Kennedy, was born in Jackson County, Oregon, on October 31, 1944. His family moved to Oskaloosa when Kenny was a teenager, and he enjoyed playing football in high school. He enlisted in the Army on November 16, 1965, and served in Vietnam, operating large equipment for road construction. Upon his return from Vietnam, he reenlisted and was stationed at Fort Benning, Georgia. It was there that he met and married Jeanie Oldnettle in 1968. After his discharge in 1971, they returned to Oskaloosa, where Kenny began his lifelong career as a truck driver. Throughout the years, Kenny drove a truck for Mahaska Bottling Company, Ideal Ready Mix, Ruan Trucking Company, Bill Moyer, hauling cars, and ultimately, Walmart.

On November 9, 1990, Kenny married Sadie Jane Thomas-Hugen at her home in Oskaloosa. Together, over several years, they fostered well over 30 children in need of a safe and loving home.

Kenny's passion was motorcycles; he was a member of the Veterans of Vietnam Motorcycle Club, raising money for veterans in need, riding in parades, and enjoying trips together.

Kenny's family includes his wife, Sadie of Oskaloosa; his children: Shawn Kennedy of Leighton, Melanie (Jeff) Tresslar of Jefferson City, Missouri, Kim (Cortney) Hayes of Oskaloosa, Cindi (Shannon) Bryan of Granger, Laura Stuchel of Oskaloosa, and Kathy (Brad Morrow) Huguen of What Cheer; 24 grandchildren and many great-grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Kenny was preceded in death by a daughter, Paula Kennedy, and a sister, Audrey Sloan.

As was his wish, Kenney's body has been cremated. The burial of his ashes will take place in Graceland Cemetery in Knoxville. 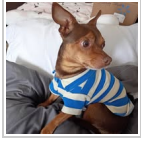

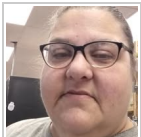
