Kyl West, 52, of Oskaloosa, passed away Friday, December 6, 2024, at his home in Oskaloosa.

Kyl Matthew West, son of Stephen Lacey and Janice Arlene (Baxter) West, was born in Sigourney, Iowa, on March 28, 1972. He was raised in Fremont and was a 1990 graduate of Eddyville-Blakesburg-Fremont High School. After finishing his education, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served three years, including time on the Air Craft Carrier Saratoga. After finishing his term of service, Kyl returned to the Oskaloosa area and worked briefly with his father in the masonry trade and Clow Valve Company before beginning a career with Kinze Manufacturing, where he learned skills as a tool and die maker. In 2005, he began working for Oskaloosa Engineering and, until recently, was the CNC technician at the plant.

In 2011, Kyl married Stacia Van Ringelestien, and a son, Noah, was born to that union. They later divorced. Kyl enjoyed fishing, riding his bicycle, and spending time with his children in his free time.

Kyl's family includes his children, Jade West and her fiancé, Caulin Riley, of Oskaloosa and Noah West of Fremont; his parents, Stephen and Janice West of Fremont; two brothers, Kevin (Amy) West of Fremont and Andrew West of Ottumwa; and a sister, Alexandra (Corey) Cook of Waukee.

Kyl's grandparents, Joe and Olive Vogel and Robert and Leola West, preceded him in death.

The memorial service for Kyl will be held at 10 a.m., Wednesday, December 11, 2024, at Langkamp Funeral Chapel, with Pastor Jon Nelson of Central Church officiating. The Oskaloosa Honor Guard will provide military honors. The family will greet visitors from 9 a.m. to service time. Memorial contributions can be to his family.
