LaVerne Van Dusseldorp, 92, of Oskaloosa, passed away, Thursday, August 11, 2016, at Oskaloosa Care Center in Oskaloosa. LaVerne was a 1942 graduate of Pella High School. She married the love of her life, Gilbert Van Dusseldorp, November 27, 1945. They began their life together on a farm near Pella and then lived on a farm near Monroe for a time. They later moved to a farm 12 miles west of Oskaloosa, where they farmed for several years. In 1979, they purchased a farm near Rose Hill. LaVerne loved her role as homemaker and mother, but she was much more than that, she was a true helpmate to her husband with the farm operation and its numerous chores. In August of 2000, they moved to Geneva Drive in Oskaloosa. After Gilbert passed away in 2006, LaVerne stayed in her home until June 2010, when she moved to Maple Ridge Assisted Living. In August 2015, she moved to Oskaloosa Care Center. LaVerne was a member of the Ebenezer Reformed Church in Leighton for many years; she later transferred her membership to the First Christian Church in Oskaloosa. She was also a member of her rural neighborhood Club. Laverne enjoyed playing the piano, sewing and embroidery.
