Lillian Van Arkel, 96, of Oskaloosa, passed away Tuesday, December 21, 2021, at Northern Mahaska Nursing and Rehab Center.

Lillian M. Van Arkel was born March 29, 1925, at the rural Lacey home of her parents, Garret and Maggie (Klein) Van Ommen. She was an 8th grade graduate of a country school and then remained at home to help her parents on the family farm. February 13, 1943, Lillian married Ralph Van Arkel shortly before he left for the military. Lillian and Ralph made their home in Oskaloosa, where she was a homemaker. Lillian was a member of the Central Reformed Church, where she was active in the women's guild. She enjoyed embroidery work.

Lillian's family includes her daughter, Donna (Ron) Ruggles of Oskaloosa; two granddaughters: Samantha Nelson of Chicago, IL and Scarlett (Jonathan) Overturf of Oskaloosa; a grandson, Dr. Brad Randleman of Atlanta, GA; four great-grandchildren: Taylor, Casey and Mia Randleman and Marshall Overturf.
