Marion Kisor: Buck passed away Friday at Mahaska Hospital in Oskaloosa at the age of 84 years, 10 months and 2 days.

Buck is survived by his son, Charles L. Kisor of West Des Moines, IA; a daughter, Lori (Jim) Hollingshead of Oskaloosa; a granddaughter, Meghan Smith of Oskaloosa and a sister, Ida Lou (Charles) LeRette of Dubuque, IA.

Marion C. Kisor, son of Danny Dale and Alice Flo Evans Kisor, was born November 27, 1921, at his parent's farm north of New Sharon, Iowa. He was a 1940 graduate of Oskaloosa High School. Buck served in the U.S. Army from September 18, 1942 to February 10, 1946. He married Dorothy Ruth Blom May 17, 1957, at the Ebenezer Reformed Church in Leighton. After returning from the service, he worked four years for Mahaska County on a surveying crew. He was then hired by Binns and Stevens as a truck driver handling explosives; working there for 35 years, retiring in January 1984. He was a member of the Harry L. Anderson Post # 34 of the American Legion. He enjoyed fishing, especially his annual trips to Leech Lake, MN, and watching Iowa Hawkeye football and basketball.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy; a sister, Grace Carruthers and a brother, Morgan Kisor.
