Marion Van Wyk: Marion Van Wyk was born April 30, 1921 to Blee and Jennie Van Mersbergen Van Wyk near Leighton, Iowa. He attended Lacey School. He served in the United States Army during World War II. On December 2, 1948 he married Martha Bokhoven. He was employed as a construction bulldozer operator, worked at Goodyear in Oskaloosa, and for the city of Oskaloosa for many years. He was a member of Oskaloosa Sheriff posse and was a night watchman in New Sharon. On October 4, 1990 he married Phyllis Terpstra in Oskaloosa. She died December 16, 2000. He was a member of Calvary Bible Church in Oskaloosa.
