buff, particularly enjoying the ""Lord of the Ring"" trilogy and the ""Star Wars"" series; and took great pride in his movie memorabilia. Mark loved his pets, especially his dog, Bandit. He was a member of the Elks and St. Paul Congregational United Church of Christ.
