Mary Curry, 90, of Oskaloosa passed away Tuesday evening, April 12, 2016, at the MHP Hospice Services Serenity House. Mary married Robert "Bob" Curry, May 26, 1984, at the Little Brown Church in Nashua. They too made their home in Oskaloosa. Mary had enjoyed camping with her husband, Harold and after her marriage to Bob, she introduced him to camping. Over their 32 years of marriage, they owned six campers and enjoyed many relaxing vacations. Mary was a member of First Church of the Nazarene where she was active in the quilting group for many years. She was a talented quilter in her own right and won blue and purple ribbons on one of the last quilts she entered at the Southern Iowa Fair. Mary was a member of the Mahaska Hospice Auxiliary. She loved to shop, and shoes were her weakness; she also enjoyed embroidery, crocheting, and crossword puzzles. Mary and Bob moved to Homestead Assisted Living in April 2013, and after breaking her hip she moved to Northern Mahaska Nursing and Rehab. Center in November of that year.
