Mildred Halverson, 97, of Oskaloosa died Sunday morning, December 15, 2013, at her home in Oskaloosa.

Mildred E. Halverson, daughter of Ben and Minnie (Quam) Monson, was born June 19, 1916, in Rake, Iowa. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. She was a 1935 graduate of Rake High School. October 31, 1936, she married Gale F. Halverson. Over the years, they lived in Thompson, LuVerne and Sioux Rapids, Iowa before coming to Oskaloosa. Mildred was a life-long member of the Lutheran faith and has been a member of St. John Lutheran Church since 1959.
