Nellie Irene Ehrenhard: Nellie passed away at her home in Oskaloosa, early Wednesday morning, at the age of 94 years and 13 days.

On Aug. 5, 1933, she married Dwight Fielder near Gibson, IA. She and Dwight moved to a farm near Fremont where they farmed together until the time of his death on April 24, 1961. Nellie married Coen Ehrenhard on July 10, 1965 in Plattsmouth, NE, Nellie was active in the farms operation until she sold it in 1996; she continued to live there until 2002 when she moved to Oskaloosa. Nellie loved the farm and caring for animals, but also enjoyed cooking and flower gardening. She was a member of the Fremont Baptist Church.
