



Omer Dale Fleck

December 9, 1914 - August 27, 2007

Omer Dale Fleck: Omer passed away and entered eternal life to be with his personal Lord and Savior, Monday at the Pella Regional Health Center.

He is survived by his wife, lola; his daughter, Ruth; his son, Dale; his grandchildren: Michael (Jessica) Rutter and Michelle (Brent) Den Hartog; his great-grandchildren: Kirsten, Brandon, Micaela, and Kinley; his brothers Ivan (Twyla) Fleck, Ray (Irene) Fleck; and his sister Rose Ella Phillips.

Omer was born at the Fleck homestead at Leighton, Iowa, on December 9, 1914 to LeRoy and Nellie loa (Cruzen) Fleck. On January 7, 1939, he married lola Dale Van Steenis at Nashua, Iowa. To this union was born Dale Eugene (of Helena, Montana) and Ruth Diann Rutter (of Kellogg, Iowa).

For 25 years Omer farmed the Fleck homestead. In 1970, Omer and lola felt called to enter inner city mission work and they moved to Kalamazoo, Michigan. Together they served the Kalamazoo Gospel Mission for 13 years. After that time they moved to Oskaloosa, Iowa to retire. However, Omer was always active and he continued to do volunteer work for the church he loved until his death. The Ebenezer Reformed Church always remained an integral part of his life, the church he joined in 1947. Omer was a member of the Sons of the Revolution and an honorary member of the International Gospel Mission.

Omer recently fought valiantly to overcome several health issues which had only become more acute during his last few months spent at Hilltop Manor in Pella, where he had moved to be somewhat closer to his wife, who is currently struggling with Alzheimer's disease at the Pella Regional Health Center.

Omer was preceded in death by his sisters, Verla Mae Shilling, Dorothy Maxine Wyscarver and his son -in- law, James T. Rutter.
