Patsy Ann Braden, 84, of Oskaloosa passed away peacefully surrounded by her family, October 5, 2016, at the MHP Hospice Serenity House.

Patsy was born in Oskaloosa on May 15, 1934 to Leonard and Rosella (Schultz) Whipple. She graduated from Oskaloosa High School in 1951 and in 1952 she married the love-of-her-life, LuVerne “Bun” Braden. She and Bun spent most of their married life in the Oskaloosa area but lived a number of years in Cedar Rapids where they still have dear friends.

She touched innumerable people's lives, spoke more kind words, gave more smiles, wiped more tears and gave more hugs than are even imaginable. She lived a life of love and service and Heaven is definitely more crowded because of Grandma Pat.

She was preceded in death by her parents, a brother Larry Whipple, a sister-in-law Connie Whipple and her infant daughter Jo Dea.
