



Paul Raymond Eveland

July 14, 1926 - March 28, 2023

Paul Eveland, 96, of Oskaloosa, passed away Tuesday, March 28, 2023, at Mahaska Health Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa.

Paul Raymond Eveland, son of Elmer Clinton and Pauline Dykstra Eveland, was born July 14, 1926, in Oskaloosa, Iowa. He was a 1944 graduate of Oskaloosa High School. He served in the Air Force during World War II. While in the military, Paul married Rosemary Potter on July 7, 1945, in Gulf Port, Mississippi. Upon his discharge from the military, he returned to the Oskaloosa area, where he farmed with his father. Paul and Rosemary remained on the family farm, which Paul worked until his retirement in 1989 and then continued living there. Paul was a member of the First Christian Church in Oskaloosa and the Elks and Eagles Lodges; he was a lifetime member of the American Legion and had served on The Honor Guard for 12 years. Paul was also a member of the Antique Airplane Association, the Nelson Pioneer Farm, and a 25-year member of the Experimental Aircraft Association. He enjoyed hunting and fishing and flew as a private pilot for over 40 years.

His family includes several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his wife, Rose, who passed away on March 24th, 2015. A son, Layne Clinton Eveland, who passed away March 21st, 1976, and twin daughters, Debra Kay and Donna Mae, who died at birth; four nephews: Mike Patik, Doug Gregan, Jim Lautenback and Russ Lautenbach; and two nieces, Tanya Potter and Barbara Patik.

Graveside funeral services with Military Honors for Paul will be held at 10 a.m., Friday, March 31st, 2023, at Forest Cemetery in the section east of the lake. Visitation will begin at 9 a.m. at Langkamp Funeral Chapel. A procession will form at 9:45 a.m. to travel to the cemetery. A Celebration of Paul's Life will be held on July 14th, Paul's birthday. The time and place are still to be determined. Memorial contributions can be made to the First Christian Church.
