Randall Ray Roorda: Randy passed away unexpectedly, Tuesday morning; he was 53 years, 3 months and 4 days of age.

Randy was born, September 7, 1959, in Oskaloosa, IA, the son of Norman L. and Dena M. Johnson Roorda. He was a 1977 graduate of Oskaloosa High School. Randy furthered his education at Indian Hills Community College, Centerville Campus, studying drafting. He later attended Central College in Pella where he studied advanced drafting. Randy worked at Pella Corp. from 1978-1993, where the majority of his career was spent in the drafting department.
