Ritta Jean Dye Myers: Ritta passed away late Saturday evening at the Sigourney Care Center where she had been a resident since January 16, 2006.

The family lived in rural Sigourney and Ritta attended school at the Lancaster School System south of Sigourney. In 1941 the family moved to St. Louis, Missouri and Ritta graduated from Blewett High School in St. Louis in 1945. After graduation Ritta joined the U.S.O. and it was there that she met Bill LeRoy Myer. They married on May 1, 1948 in Yuma, AZ. Bill's service in the Navy had them stationed in California. Ritta worked at numerous jobs before finding work with the Auto Club of Southern California in Escondido, where she worked for several years. Ritta returned to Iowa in 1968; she worked at Auto Owners Insurance, Mahaska State Bank and finally the Social Security Administration, where she worked from 1980 to 1989. Ritta enjoyed reading and flower gardening; she loved all animal and had a custom of feeding stray kittens.

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Bill, on December 24, 2004.
