Robert Emmons: Bob passed away Sunday at the Claremore Nursing Home at the age of 89 years, 3 months and 19 days.

He was a graduate of Iowa City High School and furthered his education at William Penn College in Oskaloosa where he played football. Bob married Ada Arlene Powers June 18, 1939, in Lancaster, MO. He served in the U.S. Army from June 27, 1944 to January 20, 1946. Bob and Arlene made their home in Oskaloosa, where he worked as a conductor for the C and NW Railroad. Bob retired from the railroad in 1967, and then served as a reserve officer with the Mahaska County Sheriff's Posse. He was a member of the V.F.W., the American Legion, the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen and a former member of the Tri-Luminar A.F. & A.M. Masonic Lodge.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Arlene on April 2, 1995; a son, John Victor Emmons and a stepfather, John J. Adrian.
