Roger Lee Thomas, age 53, of Beacon, passed away Monday, January 31, 2022, at Mahaska Health Partnership in Oskaloosa.

Roger Lee Thomas, son of Jerry Lee and Lida Mae (Rumbaugh) Thomas, was born August 5, 1968, in Oskaloosa, Iowa. He attended Oskaloosa High School, where he graduated in 1987. One of his first jobs was at Pamida in the '80s. Later he was hired on at Mahaska Bottling. However, it was his job at Vermeer Corporation in Pella that gave him the most joy. Roger had 28 years of service as a saw operator there. Roger truly loved the people with whom he worked.

Roger's favorite hobby was collecting. He loved the excitement of a good deal. Roger was drawn to auctions, garage sales, and the Wal-Mart clearance aisle. The thrill of finding rare items led him to be a collector of all things, including cars, Penn fishing reels & equipment, and knives.
