



## Rosemary Ruth Chance

December 21, 1922 - January 4, 2004

Rosemary Ruth (Kerr) Chance: Rosemary passed away Sunday morning at Mahaska Hospital in Oskaloosa at the age of 81 years and 14 days.

Rosemary Ruth Chance, daughter of J.E. & Bessie Shields Kerr was born Dec. 21, 1922 in Mahaska County, IA. She was a graduate of Albia High School, Albia Junior College and finished her education at Drake University in Des Moines, IA. On September 9, 1944 she married Glen Chance at the Christian Church Parsonage in Albia, IA. Rosemary began her teaching career at Lovilia and Bussey, and then taught third grade at Webster and second grade at Lincoln Elementary Schools in Oskaloosa. She taught elementary school for 30 years, retiring in 1974. Rosemary loved to read, fix jigsaw puzzles, animals and the St. Louis Cardinals; she was a member of the First Christian Church in Oskaloosa and AARP.

She was preceded in death by her parents, and two sisters, Marjorie Kerr and

Mildred Brunt.
