Shari Ewing Van Engelenhoven passed away Wednesday, January 18th, 2023, at her home in Mooresville, NC, at the age of 54.

She furthered her education at the University of Northern Iowa before transferring to Saint Ambrose University to be closer to her future husband. She graduated in 1992 from Saint Ambrose with a Bachelor's in Accounting. After ten loving years together, Richard and Shari Van Engelenhoven got married in 1997 on a romantic trip to Jamaica. After college, Shari worked in accounting until her first two children were born in 2000; it broke her heart not to be with her kids, so she chose to stay home until they were older. Republic. She loved to be outdoors and spent much of her time at beaches and pools with her kids and boating with her family. Shari had a strong faith and belief in her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. She loved her immediate and extended family and will be missed by all of them.
