Sharlene Kay Bonnema, 72, of Oskaloosa, passed away Sunday, August 17, 2025, at Mahaska Health Hospice Serenity House.

Shar was born September 28, 1952, in Sioux Center, Iowa, the daughter of Richard G. and Alma (Huenink) Bonnema. She grew up on the family farm near Lebanon, Iowa, where she especially loved working alongside her dad. She attended school in Lebanon through the eighth grade and graduated from Western Christian High School in Hull, Iowa, with the Class of 1970.

Shar continued her education at Stewart's School of Hairstyling in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. After graduating, she moved to Pella and later to Sioux Center, where she opened her salon. She loved collecting art, exploring new foods, and traveling with friends and family. Memorable trips included visiting friends in Washington State and touring Mackinac Island in Michigan. Above all, she treasured her role as aunt and great-aunt, deeply cherishing time spent with her nieces, nephews, and their children. Being part of her family's lives was her greatest joy.
